



PRUDENCE

- Sets the standards for all other virtues
- Perfects our common sense and helps us judge situations correctly
- A prudent person always prays to discern God's will



JUSTICE

- Helps us see every person is created in God's image
- Understands that each person deserves to be cared for and treated with dignity
- Helps us to recognize we must love ourselves because God first loved us



FORTITUDE

- Enables us to stay strong during challenging situations
- Enables us to bear difficulties for a greater good
- Allows us to resist temptation, avoid sin, and grow in holiness



TEMPERANCE

- Involves neither avoiding nor overindulging in what is good
- Gives us a healthy balance to desires
- Helps us keep our eyes on God while enjoying all He has given to us

SOUND JUDGMENT

Clear reasoning leading to right action; common sense

- Seeks the advice of trustworthy individuals
- Makes decisions confidently
- Good common sense

CIRCUMSPECTION

Careful consideration of the circumstances and one's options to determine the best course of action

- Carefully considers all options and consequences
- Pauses and thinks before acting
- Prays and asks God's guidance to make the right decision

DOCILITY

Willingness to learn from other people; receptivity and flexibility

- Willingness to be taught
- Enables you to keep an open mind and heart to what others say
- Desires to learn and understand more about the Faith and God's truth even if it counters one's own perspective

FORESIGHT

Consideration of the consequences of one's actions; thinking ahead

- Enables you to consider the consequences of your actions ahead of time
- Planning ahead of time so as to eliminate or lessen problems that may occur

FAIRNESS

Treating others as equals, with the same consideration that we would want them to have toward us

- Enables us to see others as equal to us
- Gives the same consideration to others that we would want them to have towards us
- Allows us to avoid favoritism and give everyone a chance to be heard

KINDNESS

Expressing genuine concern about the well-being of others; anticipating their needs

- Goes beyond giving equal shares
- Cares for another, not seeking anything in return
- Takes a genuine interest in the well-being of others
- Is compassionate and empathetic to everyone

GENEROSITY

Giving of oneself in a willing and cheerful manner for the good of others

- Gives of self willingly to bring joy to another
- Involves giving of your time and skills
- Includes giving time to your relationship with God

AFFABILITY

Being easy to approach and talk to; being friendly

- Characterized by being friendly
- Goes out of one's way to help someone feel welcome
- Makes another feel comfortable

COURAGE

Facing difficulties or dangers to do what is right regardless of the cost.

- Helps you to stand your ground despite challenges
- Gives you strength to do what is right regardless of the cost
- Allows you to hope and believe in Christ's strength even more

PATIENCE

Bearing present difficulties calmly.

- The ability to wait gracefully
- Accepts challenges calmly and continues on to overcome them
- Refrains from getting angry or despairing when things are difficult

PERSEVERANCE

Taking the necessary steps to carry out a goal despite difficulties.

- Presses on in difficult moments without giving up
- Involves finding new pathways to reaching a goal when past attempts haven't worked
- Continues to pray even when we think our prayers aren't being answered; trusting God answers all prayers

INDUSTRIOUSNESS

Diligence; working hard in the time given for it; valuing time so as to use the moments of one's life purposefully and meaningfully.

- Involves diligence
- Gets right to a task when it's given and does it carefully
- Sets aside distractions and focuses on the task at hand.

Undertaking great things, using money, time, and talents to their full potential.

- Develops gifts and talents, putting them to good use
- Uses every ability to the fullest

Having a "large soul"; self-possession and confidence based in God's goodness.

- Confidence in your self-worth and celebrating the success of others
- Sees God's goodness in each person's soul, including your own
