PRUDENCE

Circumspection	Careful consideration to determine the best course of action
Docility	Willingness to learn from other people; receptivity and flexibility
Foresight	Consideration of the consequences of one's actions; thinking ahead
Sound Judgment	Clear reasoning leading to right action; common sense

JUSTICE

Fairness	Treating others as equals, with the same consideration that we would want them to have toward us
Affability	Being easy to approach and talk to; being friendly
Courtesy	Treating others with the respect due to them as sons and daughters of God; recognizing that all are made in God's image and likeness.
Generosity	Giving of oneself in a willing and cheerful manner for the good of others
Gratitude	Having a thankful disposition of mind and heart
Kindness	Expressing genuine concern about the well-being of others; anticipating their needs
Loyalty	Accepting the bonds implicit in relationships and defending the virtues upheld by Church, family, and country
Obedience	Listening and assenting to rightful authority without hesitation or resistance
Respect	Speaking and acting according to our own and others' rights, status, and circumstances
Responsibility	Fulfilling one's just duties; accepting the consequences of one's words and actions, intentional and unintentional
Reverence	Giving due honor to God by how we behave toward Him and toward events, people, and objects associated with Him.
Sincerity	Truthfulness in words and actions; honesty and enthusiasm toward others; authenticity.
Trustworthiness	Acting in a way that inspires confidence and trust; being reliable.

FORTITUDE

Courage	Facing difficulties or dangers to do what is right regardless of the cost
Industriousness	Diligence; working hard in the time given for it
Magnanimity	Having a "large soul"; self-possession and confidence based in God's goodness
Magnificence	Undertaking great things, using money, time, and talents to their full potential
Patience	Bearing present difficulties calmly
Perseverance	Taking the necessary steps to reach a goal despite difficulties

TEMPERANCE

Moderation	Attention to balance in one's life
Clemency	Forgiving those who have hurt us and desiring good for them
Eutrapelia	Taking delight in good and honest enjoyment; moderation in the use of recreation
Honesty	Sincerity, openness, and truthfulness in one's words and actions
Humility	Awareness that all our gifts come from God, and appreciation for the gifts of others
Meekness	Serenity of spirit while focusing on the needs of others
Modesty	Purity of heart in action, especially in regards to dress and speech
Orderliness	Keeping one's self physically clean and neat and one's belongings in good order
Self-Control	Joyful mastery over one's passions and desires
Studiosness	Using one's resources to know the truth and develop intellectually
